WHEREAS, on November 3, 2023, the Vancouver City Manager issued a Declaration of Civil Emergency to protect the public peace, safety and welfare associated with the humanitarian crisis of unsheltered homelessness in the City of Vancouver (Emergency Order 2023-01), pursuant to Vancouver Municipal Code, Section 2.12.030(A)(2), which authorizes the City Manager to issue such a declaration when the Council is not in session, subject to ratification and confirmation, modification or rejection by the City Council as soon as practicable following the issuance of any such declaration; and

WHEREAS, immediately following the declaration of civil emergency, the City Manager issued two additional emergency orders on November 3, 2023: Emergency Order 2023-02 and Emergency Order 2023-03; and

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2024, the City Manager modified Emergency Order 2023-03 – and the attachments to such order – by issuing Emergency Order 2023-03.01; and

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees with the basis for, and contents of, Emergency Order 2023-03.01, and hereby adopts the same;
