Purpose of Proposed Code Change

- Update portions of Title 10 that are out of date and do not reflect preferred management practices
- Establishes a separate Rules and Regulations document
- Moves many operational rules out of code
- Re-establishes the Aviation Advisory Committee
- Codifies Aviation Advisory Committee purpose, and makeup

Pearson Tenant Review and Input

- Staff-proposed changes were circulated to the Pearson tenants for review and comment
- Staff met with interested tenants for direct feedback on June 30
- Tenant feedback and change suggestions were reviewed and revisions were included in the final draft

Rules and Regulations Document

- Proposed code revisions require City Council to adopt a new Rules and Regulations document
- Adoption of Rules and Regulations by Council resolution will allow a more streamlined path for needed future changes
- If the revised code changes are approved tonight, staff will return next week with a request to approve a resolution adopting the new Rules and Regulations
