





The Transportation System Plan (TSP) provides a transportation vision, programs, policies, and investment priorities for the next 20 years. It serves as the transportation element of the Comprehensive Plan.



Climate

Our transportation system helps to reduce our impact on the climate and our natural environment.



Equity


Transportation in Vancouver supports the needs of all and investment counteracts historic and current inequities.



Safety

Our transportation system keeps people safe when they walk, roll, bicycle, take transit, or drive.

TSP Implications

- New policies will be implemented through internal work processes and via updates to Titles IV and VI in the code
- Programs will be implemented through updates to existing workflows and standing up new programs over time
- The Transportation Improvement Program will be updated to include near-term projects identified in the TSP



Next Steps

- Remaining transportation elements required to be included in the City's Comprehensive Plan (Air, Water, Rail Freight) will be addressed through Our Vancouver process.
- Minor update to the TSP post- Comprehensive Plan Adoption to ensure full alignment
- Staff begin on implementation of 'Near-term Priorities'
- Regular updates to Council on progress implementing the TSP
